

High Officials from Government, NGOs and educational institutions visit Recycling Training Center (RTC) at Katchpur

About 19 participants including representatives from government sector, NGOs and educational institutions visited the **Recycling Training Center (RTC)** at Katchpur, Narayanganj, Greater Dhaka on February 19, 2014. The RTC is operated by Waste Concern in the partnership with UNESCAP. During this exposure visit Mr. Zubaer Ahmed, Senior Training Officer of Waste Concern demonstrated how RTC manages organic waste and promotes 3R's (reduce, reuse and recycling) of waste and Mr. Mostafezur Rahman Senior Research Officer of Waste Concern demonstrated how Biogas and electricity can be produced from different types of municipal waste. During the discussion session the participants raised important issues such as knowledge about capacity building training/tools, climate variability, scope of the study, source of knowledge, disaster risk management, specific recommendations.
