

Recycling Training Center Starts Operation from March 5, 2008 Katchpur, Dhaka

Waste Concern has started the Recycling Training Center (RTC) from March, 2008 at Katchpur near Dhaka City. RTC is processing about 7 (seven) tons of organic waste per day collected from DCC area and reducing 3.5 tons of Green House Gas (GHG) every day. The RTC is providing training to stakeholders not only on waste composting, but also on monitoring of Green House Gas emission reduction through composting using the UNFCCC approved methodology on avoiding methane emission by aerobic composting (AM 0025) which is developed by Waste Concern and its Dutch Partner WWR. The center is also providing training and field demonstration on eco-toilet, rain water harvesting, waste water recycling etc.
